- Ahmedabad SOG seized 5,050 cough-syrup bottles allegedly being sent to Mizoram, Tripura and Assam through the postal network.
- Punjab operations continue to highlight links between narcotics, foreign handlers and aerial delivery routes, with drugs and weapons being moved together.

### **Key Trends**

- Interstate and cross-border networks remain prominent, with Rajasthan–Telangana, Odisha–Maharashtra, West Bengal–Kerala and India–Sri Lanka routes emerging in recent seizures.
- Traffickers are increasingly diversifying methods and channels—digital platforms, postal networks, disguised carriers, concealed compartments and prison-based supply chains—indicating greater adaptability of organised drug networks.
- Recent operations also involved MDMA, methamphetamine, tramadol and other psychotropic substances, alongside traditional narcotics.
- Multiple cases indicate structured supply chains involving suppliers, couriers, transporters and distributors operating across states, with investigations focusing on identifying the wider network.

Strong coordinated action against organised drug trafficking was in focus as NCB's Deputy Director General (South Western Region) Vishal M. Sanap and Inspector General of Goa Police K.R. Chaurasia co-chaired the 2nd Joint Coordination Committee (JCC) meeting of 2026 for Goa Zone, an official said on Saturday.

Representatives of multiple law enforcement agencies reaffirmed their commitment to strengthening inter-agency coordination, intelligence sharing and coordinated enforcement efforts to effectively combat drug trafficking and dismantle organised narcotics networks, said the official in a statement.

The meeting was attended by senior officers from Goa Police, Customs, DRI, ED, IB, Department of Posts, FDA and police units from Goa, Maharashtra and Karnataka, it said.

The discussions focused on NCB's Vision Document (2026–2029), emerging trafficking trends, prison-based drug trafficking, use of drones for smuggling contraband, cryptocurrency-linked money laundering, seizures at Goa Airport and trafficking through postal channels, it said.

The meeting also deliberated on strengthening financial investigations in intermediate quantity cases, effective use of the PITNDPS Act against habitual offenders, timely sharing of actionable intelligence, joint interrogation and identification of clandestine drug laboratories through Red Flag Indicators (RFI).

The issue of sale of Tapentadol (Tydol) and other prescription medicines without valid prescriptions was also discussed with FDA, along with measures to strengthen enforcement. Discussions further covered withdrawal of prosecution and deportation of foreign nationals in appropriate cases.

Earlier, the NCB trained a batch of 26 Maharashtra Police officers of the rank of Inspectors and above as Master Trainers in NDPS Act enforcement in a five-day programme in UP's Ghaziabad.

Sharing information about the completion of the course in a message on X, the NCB said, "Building on the success of the first Training of Trainers (ToT) Programme conducted from 20–24 April 2026, NCB, in collaboration with BPR&D–CDTI, Ghaziabad, successfully organised the second 5-day ToT Programme from 27–31 July 2026 for Maharashtra Police officers."

"The programme trained 26 officers of the rank of Inspectors and above as Master Trainers in NDPS Act enforcement," it said.

The NCB said that with the successful completion of both programmes, Maharashtra Police now has a pool of 56 Master Trainers to further strengthen drug law enforcement capacity across the State.



# NCB Uncovers Drug Syndicates' Use of Digital Platforms for Trafficking

**Hyderabad:** The Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB), which is probing the drug trafficking case, found the instances of the use of digital platforms by drug traffickers.

The NCB's investigations have revealed use of digital platforms such as WhatsApp, Telegram, Snapchat, Zangi, Signal and social media platforms by organised drug trafficking syndicates for coordinating procurement, transportation, concealment and distribution of narcotic drugs and psychotropic substances.

This was stated by the Union Minister of State for Home Affairs, Nityanand Rai, while responding to a question raised by Telangana Rajya Sabha member M Anil Kumar Yadav on smuggling of narcotic drugs in Rajya Sabha a few days ago.

The Union Minister further stated that to curb technology enabled drug trafficking and other related criminal activities, the Central government has taken various steps through NCB.

It engaged cyber experts to enhance capability to investigate darknet enabled drug trafficking and cryptocurrency-based transactions.

Capacity building programmes are being conducted on regular basis in collaboration with the United States-Drug Enforcement Administration (US-DEA) and Rashtriya Raksha University (RRU), Gandhinagar for officers of NCB and other Drug Law Enforcement Agencies (DLEAs).

The move is aimed at strengthening capabilities in cyber-enabled narcotics investigations, digital forensics, darknet monitoring, cryptocurrency investigations and investigation of technology-enabled drug trafficking.

# US offers \$25 million reward for drug cartel figure 'Pelón'

MEXICO CITY, Mexico: The U.S. government announced this week that it is offering a US\$25 million reward for information leading to the capture of Juan Carlos González, also known as "Pelón."

It increased pressure on a U.S. citizen who has become the public face of one of Mexico's most powerful drug cartels.

The reward marks a significant increase from the previous \$5 million offer. In a broader move, the Trump administration also announced a combined \$100 million in rewards targeting several senior figures of the Jalisco New Generation Cartel (CJNG). Alongside the financial incentives, authorities imposed visa restrictions on relatives and business associates connected to cartel members.

"These sophisticated organizations use violence and fear to maintain control over the importation of deadly narcotics in the United States, including fentanyl, cocaine, meth, and other illegal drugs. Their actions spread violence and death to our communities," acting Attorney General Todd Blanche told reporters in Washington.

CJNG is one of eight Mexican cartels that the United States has formally designated as a foreign terrorist organization. The group suffered a major setback in February when its leader, Nemesio Rubén Oseguera Cervantes, known as "El Mencho," was killed during a Mexican military operation. The United States supported that mission with intelligence, though it triggered a surge in violence in the state of Jalisco.

Following his death, González, who is Oseguera Cervantes's stepson and holds dual U.S. and Mexican citizenship, has reportedly taken over leadership of the cartel. The organization is involved in a wide range of activities, from legitimate industries such as avocado production to large-scale drug trafficking.

The latest U.S. action comes just weeks after authorities imposed sanctions on 50 individuals and companies linked to the cartel, including González. Those measures froze assets and prohibited financial dealings with U.S. entities.

CJNG is widely regarded as the largest cartel operating in Mexico, with a presence in 21 of the country's 32 states. Its influence also stretches beyond Mexico, reaching into several countries, including the United States.

The Trump administration has intensified its stance toward Mexican cartels and has urged the government of President Claudia Sheinbaum to take stronger action. It has also raised the possibility of military measures against these criminal groups.

Recently unsealed indictments include charges against several individuals connected to the cartel's leadership, including Oseguera Cervantes's former son-in-law, Julio Alberto Castillo Rodriguez, and Hugo Gonzalo Mendoza Gaytan, described by officials as his godson. Authorities said all those named face charges related to drug trafficking and firearms offenses.

Officials indicated that the latest measures signal the beginning of a broader campaign targeting the cartel and its leadership.

# Four Drug Peddlers Arrested in Separate Operations Across Guwahati

GUWAHATI: Guwahati Police arrested four alleged drug peddlers in separate anti-narcotics operations across the city and seized heroin from multiple localities as part of the ongoing Assam Against Drugs campaign.

An EGPD team from Dispur Police Station arrested Rajah Singh (27), of 9 Mile, after he was caught with six vials of heroin at Khanapara.

In another operation, a CGPD team from Paltan Bazar Police Station arrested Pankaj Ray (21), of Kachari Basti, during a raid at Apsara Cinema Hall. Police recovered 11 vials of heroin weighing approximately 13 grams, along with a syringe.

Separately, an EGPD team from Basistha Police Station raided a suspected hideout at Khanapara and arrested Amar Pradhan alias Bhate (20). Police seized 39 grams of heroin packed in five tobacco boxes, along with 41 empty vials.

In a fourth operation, an EGPD team from Dispur Police Station, acting on intelligence inputs, arrested Balen Rajbongshi (30), of Baksa. He was allegedly caught carrying 3.25 grams of heroin packed in two boxes and 16 vials in his e-rickshaw near Rajdhani Mosque.

Legal action has been initiated in all four cases.

# Meghalaya ANTF nabs two, seizes heroin worth ₹7 lakh in West Jaintia Hills

**Shillong, Aug 8:** The Meghalaya Anti-Narcotics Task Force (ANTF) arrested two persons and seized 48.78 grams of heroin worth around ₹7 lakh in West Jaintia Hills on Saturday.

SP, ANTF, Vikash Kumar said the seizure was made during a joint operation with West Jaintia Hills Police based on specific intelligence.

“Acting on credible input that two individuals travelling from Silchar towards Shillong were carrying narcotics, ANTF along with West Jaintia Hills Police set up a NAKA at Phramer on NH-06,” Kumar said.

A Network Travels bus, ML-05-T-8381, was intercepted at around 8 am. Two passengers were identified as Robert Nongrum (33), of Umktait, Nongmynsong and Batskhemlang Jarain (32), of Umktait Block-III, Shillong.

“During search, two plastic soap cases concealed in a jacket were recovered. Spot testing confirmed heroin. Total net weight was 48.78 grams,” Kumar said.

He said police are now probing the source, destination and possible interstate links.

“The investigation is underway to ascertain the source, supply chain, financial trail and possible interstate linkages,” he said.

Kumar added that ANTF will continue to step up intelligence-driven operations.

“The State ANTF remains committed to intensifying enforcement against organized drug trafficking networks. We urge the public to share credible information. Such efforts will be rewarded in our fight for a Drug-Free Meghalaya,” he said.

# Matigara Police arrests 'Bullet' with 278 grams of brown sugar in Siliguri

**Siliguri, 08th August:** Matigara Police arrested a man in connection with the alleged smuggling of brown [sugar](#) and recovered 278 grams of brown sugar and an Android mobile phone from his possession.

The arrested accused has been identified as 38-year-old Mohammad Raju, alias 'Bullet'.

According to police, based on information received, a Matigara Police team conducted a raid in the Paribahan Nagar area of Siliguri on Friday evening. During the operation, the accused was apprehended while allegedly moving around in suspicious circumstances.

A search of his possession led to the recovery of 278 grams of brown sugar and an Android mobile phone. Matigara Police subsequently registered a case against him under the NDPS Act and arrested him.

The accused was produced before the Siliguri court on Saturday. Police are currently investigating the case.

## Police said the networks used private buses, trains and private vehicles to transport narcotic substances into Telangana

Hyderabad: A Rajasthan-linked drug network allegedly operating near a Hyderabad school has come under the scanner, with Telangana EAGLE Force busting two interstate trafficking networks, arresting seven people and seizing drugs worth ₹12.65 lakh.

The crackdown exposed an organised supply chain allegedly connecting Rajasthan-based suppliers with couriers, intermediaries, local peddlers and customers in Hyderabad.

Police said the networks used private buses, trains and private vehicles to transport narcotic substances into Telangana.

The operations also highlighted the growing shift towards drugs such as mephedrone (MD) and opium amid efforts to disrupt cocaine supply networks in Hyderabad.

### 78 Rajasthan-linked drug trafficking attempts since 2023

According to EAGLE Force, Telangana Police has intercepted 78 attempts since 2023 by Rajasthan-based drug networks to transport narcotics into Telangana.

Investigators found that traffickers allegedly relied on interstate transportation routes and recruited people, including young persons, as couriers, delivery agents and intermediaries.

The drugs commonly encountered in such Rajasthan-linked networks include mephedrone, opium and doda chura, police said.

### Miyapur case exposes Rajasthan–Hyderabad supply chain

In the Miyapur case, registered as Cr.No. 1151/2026, EAGLE Force, in coordination with Miyapur Police, acted on credible information on August 7.

Police apprehended three Rajasthan-linked accused and seized 1.031 kg of opium and 18 grams of mephedrone.

The investigation allegedly revealed that Rajasthan-based Mahender Kumawath had dispatched a consignment to Bengaluru through an MR Travels driver, identified as Ram Prasad.

According to investigators, Kumawath instructed his associate Madhu Ram, a resident of Goshamahal, to collect the drugs in Bengaluru and transport them to Hyderabad.

Madhu Ram allegedly travelled to Gokul Plots in Hafeezpet along with an associate to deliver the consignment to Mahendra Patel, a mobile accessories businessman.

Police said mobile phones and digital payment platforms, including UPI, were allegedly used to coordinate drug supplies and financial transactions.

### **Drug activity near Quantum Leap School raises alarm**

The most serious aspect of the Miyapur investigation is the alleged presence of drug trafficking activity near Quantum Leap School.

Telangana Police said such activity in the vicinity of an educational institution is being viewed with utmost seriousness because of the potential risk to children, students and young people.

Investigators identified Mahender Kumawath as a key supplier. He and several others allegedly linked to the supply chain are absconding, police said.

### **Saifabad case: Four held while allegedly delivering MD**

In a separate case, Cr.No. 270/2026, EAGLE Force, in coordination with Saifabad Police, apprehended four Rajasthan-linked accused near Parishram Bhawan.

Police said the accused had allegedly arrived to deliver 7 grams of mephedrone (MD) to customers.

Investigators identified Harinder Devda of Jalore district, Rajasthan, as the alleged kingpin of this network. He allegedly supplied MD to Hyderabad peddlers through his associates.

Several other persons allegedly connected to the network remain absconding.

### **Rajasthan drug links under investigation**

The Saifabad investigation has also revealed alleged links with drug-peddling activities in Rajasthan.

Police said Nagaur Police recently arrested nine persons and seized 1.5 kg of opium, with their links reportedly extending to persons associated with the same network.

EAGLE Force said investigations are being expanded to establish the complete interstate chain.

### **How the drug networks allegedly operated**

Investigators identified a recurring modus operandi:

- Narcotics were sourced from suppliers based in Rajasthan.
- Drugs were transported to Telangana through private buses, trains and private vehicles.

- Persons from Rajasthan were allegedly used as couriers and delivery agents.
- Local peddling networks were established in Hyderabad.
- Mobile phones were used to coordinate supplies and deliveries.
- UPI and other digital payment channels were allegedly used for financial transactions.
- Local support systems were allegedly used for storage, transportation and distribution.

Police said some Rajasthani dhabas and other establishments associated with interstate movement have also come under scrutiny in certain investigations for allegedly facilitating aspects of the drug trade.

### **Two MD manufacturing facilities busted**

The crackdown has also extended beyond drug transportation and peddling.

EAGLE Force said its investigations into Rajasthan-linked networks led to the detection and dismantling of two alleged mephedrone manufacturing facilities operated by a Rajasthan-based drug network.

Another MD manufacturing facility allegedly linked to a person identified as Matyasagiri was detected at Abdullapurmet, police said.

The developments indicate that synthetic-drug manufacturing has emerged as another component of the narcotics threat in Telangana.

### **Police flag growing shift to MD and opium**

EAGLE Force said sustained action against cocaine suppliers has disrupted cocaine availability in Hyderabad to a considerable extent.

According to police, local drug peddlers appear to have shifted towards alternative substances, including MDMA, mephedrone and opium.

The resulting seizures of MD and opium, along with the detection of local manufacturing units, indicate the changing nature of the drug market, police said.

### **MD poses serious health risks, police warn**

EAGLE Force warned that mephedrone is a dangerous synthetic psychoactive substance that can cause serious health complications.

Its use can result in rapid or irregular heartbeat, elevated blood pressure, anxiety, panic attacks and addiction. Severe reactions can include hallucinations, aggression and seizures, police said.

Police also expressed concern over the reported practice among some youngsters of consuming MD mixed with gutka or other substances.

### **EAGLE teams face challenges during Rajasthan raids**

EAGLE Force said its teams have faced considerable resistance while pursuing drug networks in Rajasthan.

In one operation, officers allegedly escaped electrocution, while in another, villagers reportedly attacked the police team. In yet another case, an EAGLE Force SP reportedly camped with a team for seven days but could not complete the operation.

Police stressed that tackling the lucrative drug trade requires community participation in addition to enforcement.

### **Kingpins, financiers and customers on EAGLE radar**

Investigations into both cases are continuing to identify the remaining suppliers, financiers, transporters, peddlers, intermediaries and customers.

EAGLE Force said it is tracing the financial and logistical network with the aim of dismantling the entire supply chain rather than merely arresting local peddlers.

Police also pointed to the challenges in commercial-quantity NDPS cases, stating that alleged drug kingpins sometimes engage experienced legal teams to seek bail before the statutory 180-day period.

### **Seven arrested, several suspects absconding**

Among those apprehended in the two cases are:

- Madhu Ram, 29, a Zomato delivery worker from Goshamahal and a native of Rajasthan.
- Mahendra Patel, 36, a mobile accessories businessman from Hafeezpet.
- Dharmendra, 38, a glass-house businessman from HMT Miyapur.
- Four other Rajasthan-linked accused in the Saifabad case.

Police said several suspects, including Mahender Kumawath, MR Travels driver Ram Prasad and others, are absconding.

### **Drugs worth ₹12.65 lakh seized**

The combined seizures include:

1.031 kg opium — ₹5.15 lakh

25 grams mephedrone (MD) — ₹7.5 lakh

Mobile phones, cash, vehicles and other material allegedly linked to the drug trade were also seized.

### **EAGLE Force urges parents and public to stay alert**

Telangana Police said it has adopted a zero-tolerance approach towards narcotic trafficking, particularly when drug networks operate near educational institutions and places frequented by children and young people.

Parents, teachers, educational institutions and members of the public have been urged to report suspicious activities involving drug transportation, storage, manufacturing, peddling or distribution.

Drug-related information can be reported to EAGLE Force through its toll-free number 1908 or WhatsApp: 87126 71111. Police said the identity of credible informants will be kept confidential and suitable rewards will be provided.

“Protect our youth. Break the drug chain. Build a drug-free Telangana,” EAGLE Force said.

# Special anti-drug drive: Coimbatore city police arrest 273, seize more than 10kg of ganja

COIMBATORE: The Coimbatore city police arrested 273 people and registered 215 cases during an intensive month-long storming operation conducted between July 8 and Aug 8, 2026.

According to official data released by the police department, special raids and vehicle checks were carried out across the city to curtail the movement of contraband and eradicate illegal substances.

Police registered 62 cases under the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (NDPS) Act and arrested 103 offenders. The seizures included 107 kg of ganja, 2,321 painkiller tablets, 210 bottles of unknown narcotic drugs, 5.55 grams of

methamphetamine and Rs 34,600 in cash. Additionally, police confiscated 23 vehicles -- 3 four-wheelers and 20 two-wheelers -- used for smuggling.

To combat the illicit tobacco trade, 109 cases were filed under the Cigarettes and Other Tobacco Products Act (COTPA), leading to the arrest of 118 people and the recovery of 1,778 kg of banned tobacco products. A four-wheeler, three two-wheelers and two autorickshaws were seized in connection with these violations.

Under prohibition enforcement, officers registered 44 cases, arrested 52 people and seized 107.8 litres of Indian made foreign liquor (IMFL) along with two two-wheelers.

Senior police officials warned that such special operations, raids and strict vigilance would continue relentlessly in the coming days to eliminate substance abuse and make Coimbatore a completely drug-free city.

**Tirupati:** Acting on directives from district SP L Subba Rayudu, Renigunta Urban police arrested a fourth accused in an MDMA trafficking case.

The police team conducted the operation after receiving leads from three earlier arrestees including Guna Sekhar (A-1), S Ashwin Kumar (A-2) and Rahul Yadav (A-3).

Police detained Godugu Chinta Vinod Kumar (33) near Ramana Villas Circle on Srialahasti Road. During preliminary questioning, Vinod reportedly said he works in Bengaluru as a Rapido driver and procured MDMA at low cost from a contact in Bengaluru alleged to be of Nigerian origin through WhatsApp. He admitted supplying the consignments to Tirupati and selling them to acquaintance Guna Shekhar at higher prices.

Special investigation teams have been formed to trace the supply chain, identify intermediaries and coordinate with agencies in Bengaluru to probe cross-state links.

# Malaysian national held at Chennai airport with 4 kg hydroponic ganja

CHENNAI: Customs officials arrested a Malaysian national after recovering 4.033 kg of suspected high-grade hydroponic ganja from his checked-in baggage at Chennai International Airport.

Based on passenger profiling, officers of the Air Intelligence Unit (AIU) of Chennai Customs intercepted the passenger after he arrived from Bangkok on Friday night. The passenger allegedly attempted to exit through the Green Channel without making any declaration to Customs.

During X-ray screening, his checked-in baggage showed suspicious images, following which the luggage was subjected to detailed examination.

Officials found four packets containing a greenish, lumpy substance with a sharp and pungent odour. The packets, suspected to contain high-grade hydroponic ganja (cannabis), had been concealed inside false bottoms of the baggage.

The recovered substance weighed 4,033 grams (net) and tested positive for ganja/marijuana using a narcotic drug detection kit.

The contraband was seized under Section 43(a) of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (NDPS) Act, 1985. The passenger was arrested and subsequently remanded in judicial custody.

# 297kg of ganja seized near Rameswaram; two held

Ramanathapuram: Two people were arrested for possession of 297kg ganja during a vehicle check near the Rameswaram coast in Ramanathapuram district on Friday morning.

Police sources said acting on a tip-off that ganja was being transported, a special team of police intercepted a van near Pirappanvalasai coast. A search of the vehicle led to the seizure of 297kg of ganja and arrested Dinesh, alias Karuppu Dinesh, 24, from Aatrangarai, and Kalanjeeswaran, 22, from Mandapam.

Police also seized the vehicle used for transporting the contraband.

A case was registered by Uchipuli police under relevant sections of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (NDPS) Act.

Addressing reporters, district superintendent of police G Chandeesh said that further investigation is under way to trace and arrest seven others involved in the smuggling network. He stated that the seized ganja was intended for smuggling to Sri Lanka.

# West Bengal native held with 15.18kg cannabis in Kochi

Kochi: The district anti-narcotics special action force (Dansaf) seized 15.18kg of cannabis near Edappally toll as part of Operation Toofan Narco Hunt on Saturday.

The arrested man is Ahad Ali, 26, of Kamarpur Colony in Murshidabad, West Bengal. He was apprehended within Kalamassery police station limits.

City police said they are investigating the source and supply network through which the cannabis was transported into Kerala. Possession of 15kg of ganja is a serious offence under NDPS Act. While 20kg or more is classified as a commercial quantity and 1kg or less as a small quantity, the seized contraband falls in the intermediate category, punishable upon conviction with up to 10

years' imprisonment and a fine of up to Rs 1 lakh.

The operation was conducted on the instructions of Ernakulam city police commissioner Kaliraj Mahesh Kumar and under the supervision of DCPs Aswathy Jiji and Arun K Pavithran. The Dansaf team was led by narcotics cell assistant commissioner T D Sunilkumar.

Meanwhile, as part of a special drive ahead of Onam, a team led by Angamaly excise range inspector A Vipindas conducted a night-time inspection and seized 2.06kg of ganja from a migrant worker near the old market in

Angamaly on Friday night.

The accused was identified as Lalan Sheikh, 23, of Dhanirampur village under Raninagar police station limits in West Bengal's Murshidabad.

He was arrested and produced before Angamaly court, which remanded him in judicial custody.

Puthencruz police arrested two West Bengal natives with 16kg of ganja during a raid conducted as part of Operation Toofan on Friday as well. The duo had allegedly brought the contraband from West Bengal by train and arrived in Aluva. They were later taken into custody based on a tip-off. Police said the ganja was found packed in separate packets and concealed inside a bag.

Police said the accused individuals usually buy it from West Bengal for Rs 3,000 per kg and planned to sell it locally for Rs 30,000 per kg. An investigation has been launched to identify those who buy ganja from the accused.

The seizures come less than a month after Angamaly excise range seized 116.37kg of ganja near Karukutty railway station on July 12, arresting four Odisha natives in one of Ernakulam district's biggest recent drug hauls.

# Over 12,000 participate in 'Run for Drug-Free Coimbatore' marathon

# Operation prahar: Goa police crack down on drugs mafia, 12 arrested

Panaji: Goa police launched a statewide drive “operation prahar” on Friday night to crack down the narcotics network and arrested 12 persons for allegedly being in possession of narcotic substances including ganja, LSD, cocaine, charas, ketamine and ecstasy worth Rs 10 lakh.

Goa police PRO, DSP Nilesh Rane, said that the operation resulted in the registration of 10 cases under the NDPS Act.

The operation involved coordinated action by the district police, ATS, ANC, coastal police, traffic police, crime branch and other specialised units at multiple locations.

As part of the operation, railway police also conducted surprise checks at Tivim and Margao railway stations, including in 11 trains operating on the Konkan Railway and South Western Railway routes.

“Trains vulnerable to drug trafficking were identified and subjected to intensive checking. Suspicious passengers and their belongings were searched both inside moving trains and on railway platforms. Sniffer dogs were also deployed for detection and examination of suspicious baggage,” Goa police said.

More than 120 interstate buses operating on various routes, particularly the Goa-Maharashtra and Goa-Karnataka routes, were checked at different locations and bus terminals. More than 500 passengers were subjected to

verification and checking as part of the exercise.

“Coastal police conducted surprise checks against suspected sand-mining activities at vulnerable locations to curb such illegal activities. Extensive nakabandi and vehicle checking were conducted at strategic locations across the state. More than 1000 vehicles were checked and 50 persons were rounded up for drunk driving, and necessary legal action was initiated as per law,” Goa police said.

The operation also included intensified verification of foreign nationals where two foreigners were found overstaying in Goa without valid visas, Rane said.

Such coordinated and sustained enforcement operations will continue to be undertaken to disrupt criminal networks, strengthen preventive policing and ensure the safety and security of residents and visitors to Goa, said Goa police.

Ahmedabad city SOG (Special Operation Group) team has busted the biggest racket of illegal and intoxicating cough syrup sale and transportation running in the city till date. In which, SOG raided the General Post Office (GPO) area on Relief Road based on a tip-off and seized 5,050 bottles of cough syrup worth over Rs. 60 lakh.

## Scam of sending money to North-East through postal network

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According to the details revealed in the preliminary investigation, this huge quantity of cough syrup was being sent to the north-eastern states of the country like Mizoram, Tripura and Assam through the Indian Postal Service. The SOG team received information that large parcels of cough syrup were being sent from Relief Road GPO, based on which the scam was exposed by conducting a raid. This is the first incident where such a huge quantity of illegal cough syrup has been seized from Ahmedabad city.

## A case has been registered under the NDPS Act.

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Since cough syrups containing certain chemicals used in the medical field are used for intoxication, illegal supply and sale of them constitutes a serious offence. In this case, SOG has registered a case under various sections of the Narcotics Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (NDPS) Act and is taking further legal action.

## Key points of investigation

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**Supply Chain:** From whom and from which pharmaceutical company or dealer was such a large quantity (5,050 bottles) of cough syrup purchased?

**Records Verification:** Details of how many parcels have been sent to the North-Eastern states in the past will be collected by checking the old records of the post office.

**Use of bogus names:** It is also being investigated whether bogus addresses or false names were shown on the parcels to avoid being caught during transportation.

According to SOG officials, the main conspirators involved in this racket, suppliers and buyers who ordered this quantity in the North-East will be arrested in the coming days.

# Pharmacist Arrested for Allegedly Renting Licence to Divert Codeine Cough Syrup in Gujarat

**Rajkot:** In a major crackdown on the illegal diversion of prescription medicines, Bhavnagar police have arrested a licensed pharmacist for allegedly allowing her pharmacy licence to be used to procure and distribute codeine-based cough syrup that was later sold in the black market for abuse as an intoxicant. Police claim the prescription medicine was diverted to drug peddlers and commonly consumed after being mixed with soft drinks.

The investigation began after surveillance teams arrested Vinod Vaghela and seized 66 bottles, amounting to 19.3 litres, of codeine phosphate cough syrup that was allegedly meant for illegal sale. During the probe, investigators found that the medicine had allegedly been procured using the licence of a registered pharmacist, prompting further action against those involved.

Based on the evidence gathered, Bortalav police arrested 21-year-old licensed pharmacist Deesha Bariya. According to investigators, she allegedly rented out her pharmacy licence to medical store operator Rajesh Sandish in exchange for financial benefits. Police alleged that the arrangement enabled the unlawful procurement and sale of prescription codeine syrup in violation of the provisions of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (NDPS) Act.

Investigators further alleged that Sandish used the pharmacist's licence to procure large quantities of the prescription medicine without adhering to the legal safeguards governing the sale of codeine-containing products. Police have so far arrested Vinod Vaghela, Janak Solanki, Rajesh Sandish, and pharmacist Deesha Bariya in connection with the case.

According to a recent media report in [The Times of India](#), Bhavnagar Superintendent of Police Nitesh Pandey stated that the pharmacist knowingly permitted the use of her licence for illegal activities, facilitating the diversion of codeine-based cough syrup into the black market, where such medicines were allegedly sold for abuse and intoxication.

Codeine is an opioid derived from the poppy plant and is used in prescription medicines to treat cough and relieve pain. Owing to its addictive properties and narcotic nature, medicines containing codeine can only be dispensed against a valid doctor's prescription. Police stated that drug peddlers allegedly supplied the cough syrup to addicts, who commonly mixed it with soda to achieve an intoxicating effect. Investigators are now probing the wider distribution network to determine whether additional pharmacies or individuals were involved in the illegal supply chain.

# Nagpur Crime Branch busts 30.8-Kg ganja consignment from Odisha; two arrested

**Nagpur:** The Crime Branch's Anti-Narcotics Squad has intercepted another major consignment of ganja allegedly brought to Nagpur from Odisha by road, recovering 30.8 kg of the contraband and arresting two persons during an operation in the Wathoda area.

Acting on a tip-off that a truck carrying a large quantity of ganja from Odisha was headed towards Nagpur, the Anti-Narcotics team laid a trap near Gauri Family Garden Restaurant on the service road along the Vihirgaon Outer Ring Road.

According to police, the suspects were allegedly transferring the ganja from the truck into a car when the team raided the spot. During the operation, police recovered 30.8 kg of ganja valued at around Rs 7.70 lakh.

The seized property includes an Eicher truck, a car and two mobile phones, taking the total value of the seized material to approximately Rs 23 lakh, police said.

Police identified the arrested accused as Amit Parteki, a truck driver from Ramtek, and Sheikh Sultan alias Tipu Ashpak Sheikh. Investigators allege that Parteki had transported the consignment from Odisha to Nagpur.

According to police, the consignment had allegedly been ordered by the prime suspect, Mahesh Babu alias Sabir Hassan, a resident of Hasanbagh. Police allege that Mahesh had sent his relative, Sheikh Sultan alias Tipu, to the spot in a car to collect the consignment.

While Parteki and Sheikh Sultan have been arrested, police have launched a search for Mahesh Babu alias Sabir.

A case has been registered at Wathoda Police Station under relevant provisions of the NDPS Act, and further investigation is underway to identify other persons involved in the alleged drug trafficking network and establish the source and intended destination of the consignment.

# Pune Crime: MCOCA Invoked Against Ganja Gang Operating in Kondhwa, Swargate

**Reported by Mubarak Ansari** Kondhwa, 8th August 2026: Pune police have invoked the stringent Maharashtra Control of Organised Crime Act (MCOCA) against an alleged organised gang involved in the illegal sale of cannabis (Ganja) in the Kondhwa and Swargate areas, according to a press note issued on Saturday.

The accused named in the case are Yasmin Karim Sheikh, 45, a resident of Shivnerinagar in Kondhwa Khurd; Amir Sameer Sheikh, 19, also from Shivnerinagar; and Shama alias Joharabee Mustaq Sheikh, a resident of Mahatma Phule Vasahat near the slaughterhouse in Kondhwa. Two other accused, including the alleged gang leader, are wanted, police said.

The action was taken in connection with Crime No. 328/2026 registered at Kondhwa Police Station under Sections 8(b), 20(b)(ii)(C) and 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act. Sections 3(1)(ii), 3(2) and 3(4) of MCOCA have now been added to the case.

“The gang allegedly continued its criminal activities despite earlier preventive action. Evidence was collected against its members, and a proposal seeking action under MCOCA was submitted to the senior authorities within the stipulated period,” Senior Police Inspector Santosh Khetmalas said.

Police said the alleged gang leader and four associates had previously been booked at Kondhwa and Swargate police stations for offences involving illegal cannabis sales and bodily harm. Preventive action had also been taken against them, but they allegedly continued to commit offences.

According to police, the gang had created fear in areas under the jurisdiction of Kondhwa and Swargate police stations. Its members allegedly intimidated residents and were involved in offences related to outraging the modesty of women and causing grievous hurt.

The MCOCA proposal was prepared under the guidance of Pune Police Commissioner Amitesh Kumar, Joint Commissioner of Police Sanjay Darade, Additional Commissioner of Police for the Eastern Region Manoj Patil, Deputy Commissioner of Police for Zone V Rajalakshmi Shivankar, and Wanowrie Division Assistant Commissioner of Police Ramdas Ingle.

The operation was supervised by Senior Police Inspector Santosh Khetmalas and Police Inspectors (Crime) Prashant Mandale and Santosh Choudhari.

Surveillance officer Police Sub-Inspector Sagar Pawar, Police Sub-Inspector Ravindra Gawade, Assistant Police Sub-Inspectors Shekhar Koli and Sharad Wakse, and police personnel Ekonge, Chavan, Palase and Mane collected evidence against the accused and submitted the MCOCA proposal to the senior authorities.

# More drugs recovered from house of Navelim man arrested with 3.6kg ganja

**Colva:** Colva police have recovered additional 4.5kg of suspected ganja from the residence of Issac Regan Pereira, 29, a resident of Navelim. Pereira was arrested by Colva police at Cavelossim on Thursday after he was allegedly found in possession of 3.6kg of suspected ganja.

Acting on a tip-off, police intercepted Pereira at Cavelossim and seized the suspected contraband. During the course of investigation, police said that the accused disclosed storing additional quantities of the drug at his residence in Navelim.

A police team subsequently raided his residence and recovered another 4.5kg of suspected ganja, taking the total quantity seized in the case to approximately 8.1kg, with an estimated open-market value of around Rs 8 lakh.

SP Siddhant Shirodkar said the accused had allegedly purchased the contraband in bulk and was looking for prospective customers to sell it.

Police are now investigating the source of the contraband and attempting to identify the alleged supplier. Investigators are also probing whether Pereira was preparing to deliver the drugs to a specific person or was operating independently.

Pereira has been booked under the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (NDPS) Act.

# Punjab Police Recovers 990 Illegal Firearms, 774 Kg Heroin And 15 Hand Grenades During 200-Day 'Gangstran Te Vaar'

Punjab Police's flagship anti-gangster 'Gangstran Te Vaar' has completed 200 days, emerging as one of the state's most sustained and comprehensive crackdowns on organised crime. During the operation, police conducted 1,09,087 raids across Punjab, arrested 1,532 proclaimed offenders, initiated action against more than 58,000 criminals and their associates, recovered a massive cache of illegal weapons and narcotics, and dealt a significant blow to organised criminal networks.

Launched under the leadership of the Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann Government, 'Gangstran Te Vaar' is an intelligence-driven campaign designed to dismantle organised crime syndicates through targeted enforcement, interstate and international coordination, financial investigations, and technology-driven policing.

On this momentous occasion, Director General of Police (DGP) Gaurav Yadav said the campaign has evolved into a multi-dimensional enforcement operation targeting not only gangsters but the entire ecosystem supporting organised crime. "The first 200 days of 'Gangstran Te Vaar' have demonstrated the impact of sustained, intelligence-led policing. Our strategy goes beyond arrests to dismantling the ecosystem that enables organised crime by targeting associates, finances, logistics, communication channels and overseas linkages. Punjab Police remains committed to ensuring that there is no safe haven for gangsters operating within or outside the country," he said.

During the 200-day operation, 1,532 proclaimed offenders (POs) were arrested, while action was initiated against 58,212 persons, including 853 gangsters and their associates and 57,359 wanted criminals. As part of preventive policing measures, 28,201 persons, including 577 gangsters and their associates and 27,624 wanted criminals, were detained, while 18,514 persons, including 1,529 gangsters and their associates and 16,985 wanted criminals, were verified and subsequently released. Overall, police action during the campaign covered 1,04,927 persons, comprising 2,959 gangsters and their associates and 1,01,968 wanted criminals.

Beyond arrests, the campaign has focused on reducing the operational capability of organised gangs by targeting their access to weapons, narcotics, finances and logistical infrastructure. The operation also substantially weakened the firepower of organised gangs, with Punjab Police recovering 990 illegal firearms, 242 sharp-edged weapons, 2,739 rounds of ammunition, 315 magazines, 2.5 kg of explosives and 15 hand grenades, significantly disrupting the operational capability of criminal networks.

Simultaneously, Punjab Police intensified its action against the organised crime-drug nexus by recovering 774.38 kg of heroin, 480.23 kg of opium, 7,266.26 kg of poppy husk and 26,91,455 intoxicant tablets. Police also seized drug money worth ₹1,73,41,965, cash amounting to

₹1,80,54,446 and 413.85 grams of gold, disrupting the financial channels that sustain organised crime and the narcotics trade.

Additional Director General of Police, Anti-Gangster Task Force (AGTF), Pramod Ban said the operation has increasingly focused on dismantling organised crime networks rather than merely arresting individual offenders “Organised crime today functions through financial networks, digital communication and handlers operating from foreign soil. Accordingly, our investigations combine field operations with financial tracking, digital intelligence and close coordination with Central agencies. This approach has enabled Punjab Police to crack extortion rackets, identify foreign-based handlers and pursue the deportation and extradition of wanted criminals. At the same time, the campaign has sent a strong message to the youth that the glamour associated with gangster culture is nothing but an illusion leading to crime and destruction,” he said.

The campaign has also been supported through regular coordination with neighbouring states and Central investigation and intelligence agencies, enabling seamless information sharing and joint operations against organised crime networks.

One of the defining achievements of the campaign was the successful deportation of fugitive gangster Bhuvnesh Chopra alias Ashish Chopra, son of Hira Lal, resident of #15, inside Delhi Gate, Ferozepur from Central Asia and gangster Jobanjit Singh alias Joban Billa from Jakarta, Indonesia. Executed by the Anti-Gangster Task Force (AGTF) in close coordination with OFTEC Punjab and Central agencies, the operation underscored Punjab Police’s growing capability to pursue wanted criminals beyond national borders and ensure they are brought back to face the law.

Besides targeting gangsters and their associates, the operation also resulted in the recovery and destruction of 64,402.77 litres / 34,840 bottles / 926 boxes of illicit liquor, seizure of 4,978 mobile handsets used in criminal activities, and impounding of 1,781 vehicles and 61 drones. Collectively, these actions have disrupted criminal infrastructure, weakened organised crime networks and reinforced Punjab Police’s sustained commitment to enhancing public safety across Punjab.

Anti-Gangster Task Force (AGTF) has also launched a dedicated tipline, 93946-93946, enabling citizens to anonymously share information about wanted criminals, gangsters and related criminal activities. The initiative allows the public to confidentially provide actionable intelligence without fear of exposure, helping the AGTF swiftly track down and apprehend gangsters and other criminals.

To further strengthen public participation, the AGTF has also introduced a reward policy offering cash incentives for credible information leading to action against wanted gangsters and criminals, while ensuring complete confidentiality of informants. The initiative is expected to significantly bolster intelligence-led operations against organised crime across Punjab.

## **Delhi Police arrested five alleged traffickers after seizing heroin and MDMA across Delhi-NCR. The case points to an organised supply chain with more links now under scrutiny.**

Delhi Police has arrested five alleged drug traffickers, including three foreign nationals, and said it has busted an interstate syndicate operating across Delhi-NCR. Police said they recovered heroin and MDMA worth around Rs 12 crore in the international market.

The accused have been identified as Nigerian nationals Moris Okalie, 52, and Ibegbu Chigozie Samuel, 50, Ghanaian national Emmanuel, 38, and Delhi residents Sameer, 28, and a woman identified as Lady, 36. Police said the group was allegedly involved in the procurement, storage, transportation and distribution of heroin and MDMA through an organised network of associates.

The Crime Branch said it had been developing intelligence on drug traffickers when it received specific information that Okalie would arrive near a hospital in Shahdara during the intervening night of July 19 and 20 to deliver a drug consignment. "A trap was laid, and Okalie was apprehended while carrying a black shoulder bag. A search of the bag led to the recovery of 2.004 kg of heroin and 863 grams of MDMA," a senior police officer said. A case was then registered at the Crime Branch police station.

# Cross-border smuggling networks: Persistent threat to India's security

Cross-border smuggling networks operating along the India-Pakistan frontier continue to pose a significant challenge to national security, combining the illicit movement of narcotics, arms and explosives with elements of terrorism. These networks, often directed by handlers based across the border and supported by local associates in India, have been repeatedly highlighted in investigations by agencies such as the National Investigation Agency (NIA), Border Security Force (BSF) and Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB).

A recent example came on August 7, 2026, when the NIA charged two people with smuggling an improvised explosive device, a firearm, and heroin across the border. The plan included attacks in Punjab and Delhi and an attempt to target a passenger train. This case shows how these networks mix drug trafficking with gathering materials for violence. The NIA says its investigation is still ongoing to find more members and the routes used to move contraband.

These networks often use Punjab and Rajasthan as main entry points because they are close to the border. Much of the heroin comes from the Afghanistan-Pakistan region, and the money from this trade often funds terrorist activities in Jammu and Kashmir and Punjab. Security agencies have confirmed that foreign groups use drug smuggling to raise money for terror groups in these areas.

In recent years, authorities have seen the problem grow. NCB data from 2025 shows a big increase in cases, especially in Punjab, where most aerial deliveries of contraband happen. Each year, hundreds of kilograms of drugs are seized in Punjab and nearby areas, showing both the scale of smuggling and the strong response from law enforcement. At the same time, foreign-made weapons are also being found, highlighting how arms and drugs often move together.

The effects go beyond security. Large amounts of narcotics entering border states cause public health problems, especially in Punjab, where addiction is a major issue. The illegal trade also hurts the economy by undermining [legal](#) businesses and creating hidden funds that support organised crime and extremism. These networks also threaten national security by enabling attacks that disrupt public order and important infrastructure.

Indian agencies have increased their efforts. The NIA, BSF, state police, and the Enforcement Directorate (ED) are working together and have made several arrests, seized large amounts of goods, and disrupted money trails. They are trying to find handlers in Pakistan, local contacts, and distribution networks in different States. They are also checking other possible routes, such as those on the western coast. Using technology and sharing intelligence are important parts of their work, with the main goal of breaking up the smuggling networks.

Even with these successes, the networks keep adapting, so the problem continues. Cases like the recent NIA investigation show that ongoing vigilance, interagency cooperation, and strong legal action under laws like the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act (UAPA) and the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (NDPS) Act remain essential.

Tackling the connections between smuggling, organised crime, and terrorism is vital to protect India's borders and internal security, security experts say.

The Counter Intelligence (CI), Ferozepur, in a joint operation with the Border Security Force (BSF) busted a major cross-border drug-smuggling network with the arrest of two people and recovery of 30.2-kg heroin on Saturday.

Punjab DGP Gaurav Yadav said that the arrested accused have been identified as Sukhwinder Singh of Walle Shah Uttar village in Fazilka district, and Manpreet Singh of Nawan Hasta village, Fazilka. Police also seized a bike (PB-05-AS-9856) allegedly being used for smuggling activities.

The DGP said the investigation was underway to establish the forward and backward linkages of the cross-border narcotics network and identify other persons associated with the handlers operating across the border.

Gursewak Singh, AIG, Counter Intelligence, Ferozepur, said the operation was launched on the basis of specific intelligence inputs.

A case has been registered at the State Special Operation Cell, Fazilka, under Sections 21-C, 25 and 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (NDPS) Act.

### **Drone carrying pistol seized in Fazilka**

The police in a joint effort with the BSF recovered a drone carrying a Chinese-made pistol, two magazines and four live cartridges from a paddy field in Gahle Wala village near the international border.

The authorities said the recovery was made when a police party was conducting patrol and checking in the area.

While on patrol, a police team arrived at Chak Bajida village and received information that a drone had crashed in a paddy field belonging to Baldev Singh of Gahle Wala village. On search, a DJI drone bearing the marking "MAVIC 4 PRO" was recovered. A .30-calibre Norinco pistol, stated to be made in China, along with two magazines and four live rounds, was also found with the drone.

Police registered a case under Sections 10/11/12 of the Aircraft Act and Sections 25/54/59 of the Arms Act against unidentified persons. Further investigation is underway.

## CBN team from MP seizes 22K tramadol tablets, opium-laced pills in Rajasthan; 4 held

Indore: The Central Bureau of Narcotics (CBN) seized 22,000 tramadol tablets and 190 grams of opium-laced pills in two operations in Rajasthan's Chittorgarh district, arresting four people allegedly involved in their possession and transportation, officials said on Saturday.

On Aug 7, CBN officials received specific intelligence about the transportation of psychotropic substances. A team from the office of the deputy narcotics commissioner, Madhya Pradesh, intercepted a bus on the Chikarda-Mandphiya road near a family restaurant in Karauli village of Bhadesar tehsil. Two passengers were searched, and 12,000 tramadol tablets were allegedly found in two backpacks they were carrying.

The two men could not produce authorisation for possessing or transporting the tablets, following which they were arrested and the substance seized under relevant provisions of the NDPS Act, 1985, officials said.

In another operation, the team searched a room of a hotel on Bhadsoda Road in Mandphiya following another intelligence input. A blue trolley bag in the room allegedly contained 10,000 tramadol hydrochloride tablets weighing 8 kg and 190 grams of opium-laced "Kamini Vidravan Ras" tablets.

Two men present in the room were unable to produce valid documents for the medicines and narcotic substance and were arrested, officials said.

The CBN said further investigation in both cases was underway to ascertain the source and intended destination of the seized substances.

## 2 held with charas like substance

Following the recovery, police registered FIR No. 12/2026 at Police Station Gurez under Sections 18 and 20 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (NDPS) Act.

Police have taken up further investigation to ascertain the source of the suspected contraband and determine whether the accused were linked to a wider narcotics network.

सात ग्राम चिट्टा बरामदगी मामले में दोषी को दो साल का कठोर कारावास

शिमला, 08 अगस्त (हि.स.)। मादक पदार्थ बरामदगी के एक मामले में पुलिस की जांच और अदालत में प्रभावी पैरवी के बाद आरोपित को सजा सुनाई गई है। अतिरिक्त जिला एवं सत्र न्यायाधीश-2, शिमला की अदालत ने एनडीपीएस अधिनियम के तहत दोषी रणवीर सिंह को दो वर्ष के कठोर कारावास और 25 हजार रुपये जुर्माने की सजा सुनाई है।

अदालत ने यह फैसला बालूगंज थाना में दर्ज प्राथमिकी से संबंधित मामले में सुनाया। मामला एनडीपीएस अधिनियम की धारा 21 के तहत दर्ज किया गया था। दोषी रणवीर सिंह, पुत्र रूप लाल मंडी जिले के सुंदरनगर का निवासी है।

पुलिस के अनुसार, मामले में रणवीर सिंह के कब्जे से करीब सात ग्राम चिट्टा बरामद किया गया था। बरामदगी के बाद बालूगंज थाना में प्राथमिकी दर्ज कर पुलिस ने जांच शुरू की। जांच के दौरान पुलिस ने मामले से जुड़े साक्ष्य जुटाए और आवश्यक कानूनी प्रक्रिया पूरी की।

पुलिस के मुताबिक, मामले की जांच वैज्ञानिक तरीके और निर्धारित कानूनी प्रावधानों के अनुसार की गई। जांच में जुटाए गए साक्ष्यों को अदालत के समक्ष प्रस्तुत किया गया। पुलिस की ओर से मामले में प्रभावी पैरवी के बाद अदालत ने रणवीर सिंह को दोषी ठहराया और दो वर्ष के कठोर कारावास की सजा सुनाई।

अदालत ने दोषी पर 25 हजार रुपये का जुर्माना भी लगाया है। जुर्माना अदा नहीं करने की स्थिति में उसे एक महीने का अतिरिक्त कठोर कारावास भुगतना होगा।

शिमला के वरिष्ठ पुलिस अधीक्षक (एसएसपी) गौरव सिंह ने कहा कि पुलिस मादक पदार्थों की तस्करी और अवैध कारोबार के खिलाफ लगातार कार्रवाई कर रही है। उन्होंने कहा कि नशे से जुड़े मामलों में आरोपितों के खिलाफ कार्रवाई के साथ-साथ गुणवत्तापूर्ण जांच और अदालत में प्रभावी पैरवी पर भी विशेष ध्यान दिया जा रहा है।

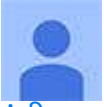

पंचकूला। नशा तस्करों के खिलाफ चलाए जा रहे ऑपरेशन ट्रैकडाउन के तहत क्राइम ब्रांच-2 ने सेक्टर-20 क्षेत्र से 204 ग्राम हेरोइन के साथ सुरेंद्र उर्फ लाला को गिरफ्तार किया है। आरोपी हिसार के बरवाला का निवासी है और फिलहाल जीरकपुर में रह रहा था। डीसीपी क्राइम एंड ट्रैफिक आईपीएस अमरिंदर सिंह ने बताया कि सूचना मिली थी कि आरोपी सेक्टर-20 स्थित सीवरेज ट्रीटमेंट प्लांट के पास हेरोइन सप्लाय करने के लिए खड़ा है। पुलिस टीम ने मौके पर पहुंचकर उसे काबू किया और तलाशी के दौरान 204 ग्राम हेरोइन बरामद की। थाना सेक्टर-20 में एनडीपीएस एक्ट के तहत मामला दर्ज किया गया है। अदालत ने आरोपी को चार दिन के पुलिस रिमांड पर भेज दिया है। संवाद

**सिरसा जिले में 08 अगस्त को पुलिस की कारेवाई के दौरान छह नशा तस्करों को गिरफ्तार किया गया है। सीआईए और एंटी नारकोटिक्स सेल की टीमों ने आरोपियों के पास से लाखों रुपये की हेरोइन और एक स्कॉर्पियो गाड़ी बरामद की है।**

**सिरसा:** पुलिस ने 08 अगस्त को नशा तस्करों के खिलाफ अभियान चलाते हुए जिले के अलग-अलग क्षेत्रों से छह आरोपियों को गिरफ्तार किया है। प्राप्त जानकारी के अनुसार पुलिस ने इन तस्करों के कब्जे से लाखों रुपये कीमत की हेरोइन बरामद की है। शहर थाना प्रभारी ने शनिवार को इस कारेवाई के संबंध में जानकारी दी है।

## सरकारी अस्पताल के पास स्कॉर्पियो से 68 ग्राम हेरोइन बरामद

पुलिस के अनुसार सीआईए सिरसा पुलिस की एक टीम इलाके में गश्त पर मौजूद थी। गश्त के दौरान पुलिस टीम को सिरसा के सरकारी अस्पताल के पास एक स्कॉर्पियो गाड़ी आती हुई दिखाई दी। सामने पुलिस टीम को देखकर स्कॉर्पियो गाड़ी के चालक ने गाड़ी को तुरंत वापस मोड़ लिया और मौके से भागने की कोशिश की।

गाड़ी चालक के इस तरह भागने के प्रयास से पुलिस को उस पर शक हो गया। पुलिस ने तत्परता दिखाते हुए जांच के लिए स्कॉर्पियो गाड़ी को रोक लिया। उस समय गाड़ी में चार युवक सवार थे। जब पुलिस ने गाड़ी की पूरी तरह से तलाशी ली, तो उसमें से 68 ग्राम हेरोइन बरामद की गई।

पुलिस की पूछताछ में गाड़ी में सवार चारों आरोपियों की पहचान सिरसा जिला निवासी कुनाल, सिरसा जिला निवासी दीपक, सिरसा जिला निवासी शिवा और सिरसा जिला निवासी रोहित के रूप में की गई। पुलिस ने इन चारों आरोपियों के खिलाफ थाना शहर सिरसा में मामला दर्ज करके आगे की जांच शुरू कर दी है।

## गांव रघुआना से नौ ग्राम हेरोइन संग एक युवक पकड़ा गया

इसके अलावा नशा तस्करी पर कारेवाई करते हुए एंटी नारकोटिक्स सेल की टीम ने भी सफलता हासिल की है। एंटी नारकोटिक्स सेल ने गांव रघुआना क्षेत्र से एक युवक को गिरफ्तार किया है। पुलिस ने आरोपी के पास से नौ ग्राम हेरोइन बरामद की है।

पुलिस जांच में गिरफ्तार किए गए आरोपी की पहचान सिरसा जिला निवासी हुशनप्रीत के रूप में हुई है। आरोपी हुशनप्रीत के खिलाफ थाना बड़ागुढ़ा में मामला दर्ज कर लिया गया है और पुलिस ने मामले की जांच शुरू कर दी है।

## गांव कालावाली से स्वराज सिंह सात ग्राम हेरोइन के साथ काबू

नशे के खिलाफ जारी इस कारेवाई के तहत तीसरी सफलता सीआईए कालावाली पुलिस टीम को मिली है। सीआईए कालावाली पुलिस ने गांव कालावाली क्षेत्र से एक आरोपी को काबू किया है। पुलिस ने तलाशी के दौरान उसके पास से सात ग्राम हेरोइन बरामद की है।

पुलिस के मुताबिक पकड़े गए आरोपी की पहचान स्वराज सिंह के रूप में की गई है। आरोपी के खिलाफ कालावाली थाना में मामला दर्ज कर जांच शुरू कर दी गई है।

**जागरण संवाददाता, कपूरथला।** केंद्रीय जेल कपूरथला में कड़ी सुरक्षा और जैमर की व्यवस्था के बीच एक बार फिर नशीला पदार्थ मिलने से जेल प्रशासन की कार्यप्रणाली पर सवाल खड़े हो गए हैं। इस बार नशे की बरामदगी जेल के अंदर बने अस्पताल के टीबी वार्ड से हुई है। यहां टीबी का इलाज करवा रहे एक कैदी के पास से तलाशी के दौरान 12 ग्राम नशीला पदार्थ बरामद किया गया।

जेल प्रशासन की शिकायत पर पुलिस ने मामला दर्ज कर जांच शुरू कर दी है। जेल प्रशासन को गुप्त सूचना मिली थी कि अस्पताल परिसर में नशीला पदार्थ मौजूद है। इसके बाद जेल परिसर के अस्पताल में विशेष तलाशी अभियान चलाया गया। पत्र संख्या 1628-सीटीआर के अनुसार, तलाशी के दौरान टीबी वार्ड में इलाज करा रहे कैदी के पास से 12 ग्राम नशीला पदार्थ बरामद हुआ।

पुलिस के अनुसार, पकड़े गए कैदी की पहचान राहुल पुत्र पूर्ण सिंह के रूप में हुई है। वह मूल रूप से जालंधर जिले के रामा मंडी थाना क्षेत्र स्थित एकता नगर फेस-दो का रहने वाला है। टीबी के इलाज के लिए उसे जेल के अस्पताल के वार्ड में रखा गया था। इसी दौरान उसके पास नशीला पदार्थ मिलने से जेल की सुरक्षा व्यवस्था पर सवाल उठने लगे हैं।

## टीबी के इलाज के बीच नशे का सामान कैसे पहुंचा?

सबसे बड़ा सवाल यह है कि जेल की कड़ी सुरक्षा के बावजूद नशीला पदार्थ अस्पताल के टीबी वार्ड तक कैसे पहुंचा। जेल में प्रवेश करने वाले सामान और लोगों की निगरानी के साथ मोबाइल नेटवर्क को रोकने के लिए जैमर लगाए जाने का दावा किया जाता है। इसके बावजूद एक कैदी तक नशीला पदार्थ पहुंचने से जेल प्रशासन की निगरानी व्यवस्था पर सवाल उठना स्वाभाविक है।

पुलिस अब यह पता लगाने में जुटी है कि नशीला पदार्थ कैदी तक किस माध्यम से पहुंचा। जांच में जेल के भीतर से किसी व्यक्ति की मदद मिलने की संभावना से लेकर मुलाकात के दौरान किसी बाहरी व्यक्ति के जरिए नशा पहुंचाए जाने के पहलू को भी शामिल किया गया है।

## जेल के अंदर का कनेक्शन तो नहीं?

बरामदगी के बाद जेल प्रशासन ने तुरंत थाना कोतवाली पुलिस को लिखित शिकायत दी। पुलिस ने मादक पदार्थ निषेध अधिनियम की संबंधित धाराओं के तहत मामला दर्ज कर लिया है। बरामद पदार्थ को कब्जे में लेकर जांच के लिए विधि विज्ञान प्रयोगशाला भेजा गया है। जांच रिपोर्ट आने के बाद यह स्पष्ट होगा कि बरामद पदार्थ किस प्रकार का नशीला पदार्थ है।

पुलिस इस बात की भी जांच कर रही है कि कैदी तक यह नशीला पदार्थ पहुंचाने में जेल के भीतर किसी व्यक्ति की भूमिका तो नहीं थी। इसके अलावा कैदी की मुलाकातों, उससे मिलने वाले लोगों और जेल में उसके संपर्कों की भी जानकारी जुटाई जा रही है।

### **पहले से नशे के नेटवर्क की जांच में जुटी पुलिस**

जांच अधिकारी मुख्य हेड कांस्टेबल अमृतपाल सिंह के अनुसार मामले की हर कड़ी को खंगाला जा रहा है। पुलिस बरामदगी के स्रोत से लेकर इसे जेल के अंदर पहुंचाने वाले व्यक्ति तक पहुंचने का प्रयास कर रही है। कैदी से पूछताछ के आधार पर पुलिस उसके संपर्कों और नशीले पदार्थ की आपूर्ति करने वाले लोगों की पहचान करने में जुटी है।

**Haryana News:** हिसार पुलिस ने नशे के खिलाफ कार्रवाई करते हुए एक युवक को एक किलो से ज्यादा अफीम के साथ गिरफ्तार किया है। पुलिस के अनुसार, गिरफ्तार युवक हिसार जेल गारद में तैनात एक सब इंस्पेक्टर का बेटा है। आरोपी को हिरासत में लेकर पुलिस ने मामले की जांच शुरू कर दी है। पुलिस को शक है कि आरोपी अफीम की सप्लाई करने के काम से जुड़ा हो सकता है। उसके पास से बरामद अफीम की मात्रा एक किलो से ज्यादा बताई जा रही है। पुलिस अब यह पता लगाने में जुटी है कि आरोपी के पास इतनी बड़ी मात्रा में नशीला पदार्थ कहां से आया और इसे कहां पहुंचाया जाना था।

## पूछताछ में खुल सकते हैं कई राज

गिरफ्तारी के बाद पुलिस आरोपी से पूछताछ कर रही है। जांच के दौरान उसके संपर्क में रहने वाले लोगों और नशे की सप्लाई से जुड़े नेटवर्क के बारे में जानकारी जुटाई जा रही है। पुलिस यह भी पता लगाने का प्रयास कर रही है कि आरोपी पहले से किसी आपराधिक गतिविधि में शामिल रहा है या नहीं।

## पुलिस ने शुरू की आगे की कार्रवाई

अफीम बरामद होने के बाद पुलिस ने आरोपी के खिलाफ संबंधित धाराओं के तहत कार्रवाई शुरू कर दी है। बरामद नशीले पदार्थ की जांच भी कराई जा रही है। पुलिस का कहना है कि मामले की जांच आगे बढ़ने के साथ इस नेटवर्क से जुड़े अन्य लोगों के नाम भी सामने आ सकते हैं।

## नशे के खिलाफ अभियान जारी

हिसार पुलिस की ओर से जिले में नशे के खिलाफ लगातार अभियान चलाया जा रहा है। पुलिस अधिकारियों का कहना है कि नशीले पदार्थों की तस्करी और सप्लाई करने वालों के खिलाफ सख्त कार्रवाई की जाएगी। फिलहाल गिरफ्तार युवक से पूछताछ जारी है और पुलिस मामले की पूरी कड़ी जोड़ने में जुटी हुई है।

कुमारसैन पुलिस ने मामले में दूसरी गिरफ्तारी की, जांच जारी

संवाद न्यूज एजेंसी रामपुर बुशहर। कुमारसैन थाना पुलिस ने पांच किलोग्राम अफीम डोडा बरामदगी मामले में मुख्य सप्लायर को गिरफ्तार कर लिया है। इस मामले में यह दूसरी गिरफ्तारी है। इससे पहले 30 जुलाई को इस खेप के साथ एक आरोपी को गिरफ्तार किया था।

यह मामला 30 जुलाई को कुमारसैन पुलिस थाना में एनडीपीएस अधिनियम की धाराओं के तहत दर्ज किया गया था। पुलिस ने सैज क्षेत्र में वाहनों की जांच के दौरान एक टैक्सी को रोका। टैक्सी की डिक्की से लगभग पांच किलोग्राम अफीम डोडा बरामद किया गया। कुमारसैन तहसील के निवासी पिकू राम (42) को गिरफ्तार किया गया। पुलिस ने मामले की गहन जांच शुरू की। तकनीकी साक्ष्यों और पिछली कड़ियों की जांच के आधार पर मुख्य सप्लायर की पहचान की गई। कुल्लू जिले की आनी तहसील के निवासी बिट्टू ठाकुर (31) को गिरफ्तार किया गया। जांच में उसकी भूमिका मादक पदार्थ की आपूर्ति करने वाले प्रमुख आरोपी के तौर पर सामने आई। बिट्टू ठाकुर को न्यायालय में पेश किया गया, जहां से उसे जेल भेज दिया गया है। एसएसपी गौरव सिंह ने बताया कि मामले में की जांच जारी है। शिमला पुलिस नशा तस्करी के विरुद्ध लगातार अभियान चला रही है।

कोटा। नशा मुक्त भारत अभियान के तहत मादक पदार्थों के खिलाफ चलाए जा रहे अभियान में केंद्रीय नारकोटिक्स ब्यूरो (CBN) की राजस्थान यूनिट ने कोटा में बड़ी कार्रवाई की है। टीम ने 1.368 किलोग्राम अवैध चरस बरामद कर दो व्यक्तियों को गिरफ्तार किया है।

CBN को गुप्त सूचना मिली थी कि दो व्यक्ति कोटा के जेडीबी कॉलेज सर्किल के पास चरस के आदान-प्रदान के लिए मिलने वाले हैं। सूचना के आधार पर केंद्रीय नारकोटिक्स ब्यूरो, झालावाड़ डिवीजन की टीम ने 6 अगस्त को कार्रवाई की। टीम ने संदिग्ध मार्ग पर निगरानी रखते हुए जेडीबी कॉलेज सर्किल, सीवी गार्डन के सामने दोनों संदिग्धों को रोक लिया। तलाशी के दौरान उनके पास मौजूद बैग से 1.368 किलोग्राम अवैध चरस बरामद हुई।

कानूनी प्रक्रिया पूरी करने के बाद चरस को जब्त कर लिया गया। दोनों आरोपियों को एनडीपीएस अधिनियम, 1985 के प्रासंगिक प्रावधानों के तहत गिरफ्तार किया गया है। मामले में आगे की जांच और कार्रवाई जारी है।

बलिया के तियरा गांव निवासी जगजीत लंबे समय से मादक पदार्थों की तस्करी कर रहा है। अच्छा मुनाफा मिलने की वजह से इसने अपने 19 वर्षीय बेटे को भी अपने साथ शामिल कर लिया।

दोनों गांजा लेकर तिलहर के सरयू स्थित बंद सरसों तेल के गोदाम के पास पहुंचे थे। एसटीएफ बरेली को जब इसके बारे में जानकारी हुई तो वह तिलहर पुलिस के साथ मौके पर पहुंच गए। दोनों को गिरफ्तार कर लिया गया। मौके से 36 किलो गांजा बरामद किया।

आरोपितों ने बताया कि बलिया से गांजा लाकर तिलहर निवासी एक व्यक्ति को देने आए थे। हालांकि उस व्यक्ति का दोनों नाम नहीं बता पा रहे। जिसे गांजा देना था वह खुद यहां आने वाला था लेकिन पुलिस को देखकर नहीं पहुंचा।

# Ganja Smugglers Use Milk Jars To Evade Detection In Balangir, 3 Arrested

**Balangir:** In an unusual smuggling bid, the Tusura Excise Department seized 44 kg of ganja allegedly concealed in milk jars being transported on motorcycles in Odisha's Balangir district on Saturday, arresting three persons in connection with the case.

The contraband was allegedly being transported in milk jars loaded on motorcycles along the Kukurkhai-Tusura road, in what officials described as a bid to conceal the illegal consignment.

Acting on a tip-off, the Tusura Excise Department laid an ambush near Kukurkhai Chowk under Deogaon police station limits and intercepted two motorcycles carrying the suspected smugglers.

The arrested persons were identified as Mohit Baishnab, Suraj Mahan and Raju Bansal, all residents of the Bilaspur area of neighbouring Chhattisgarh. According to the Excise Department, they were allegedly transporting the ganja from the Deuli area of Boudh district towards Balangir.

The officials seized the ganja along with the two motorcycles and several vehicle number plates belonging to different states. While the initial seizure was reported at around 43 kg, Tusura Excise Inspector Srikant Panigrahi later confirmed that the total quantity of ganja confiscated was 44 kg.

The seizure comes amid concerns over the continued use of routes in and around Tusura for the movement of ganja to other states. The area lies close to the borders of Balangir, Kandhamal and Boudh districts.

According to officials, routes including Gudvela-Jamut and Tusura-Deogaon are allegedly being used to transport ganja towards destinations in Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Delhi and Chhattisgarh.

The Excise Department and police have been conducting raids to curb the illegal trade, but the suspected smuggling network continues to pose a challenge in the region. Further investigation is underway to ascertain the source of the seized contraband and identify others allegedly involved in the smuggling network.

# नशे के कारोबार पर बड़ा प्रहार: पटना में कोडीन सिरप के गोदाम पर रेड, 44 लाख से अधिक की नशीली दवा बरामद

**Patna Crime News:** पटना सिटी के अगम कुआं थाना क्षेत्र में कोडीन सिरप के अवैध भंडारण के खिलाफ बड़ी कार्रवाई हुई। शिवानी कॉलोनी में छापेमारी के दौरान 44 लाख रुपये से अधिक की कोडीन सिरप बरामद की गई और एक युवक को गिरफ्तार किया गया।

**Patna Crime News:** पटना सिटी के अगम कुआं थाना क्षेत्र के शिवानी कॉलोनी में नशीली दवा कोडीन सिरप के अवैध भंडारण के खिलाफ बड़ी कार्रवाई की गई है। छापेमारी के दौरान भारी मात्रा में कोडीन सिरप बरामद की गई है, जिसकी अनुमानित कीमत 44 लाख रुपये से अधिक बताई जा रही है। मामले में एक युवक को गिरफ्तार किया गया है, जबकि अन्य आरोपियों के फरार होने की बात सामने आई है।

बताया जाता है कि ईआईबी (इंटेलिजेंस ब्यूरो) और मद्य निषेध विभाग के अधिकारियों की सूचना और नेतृत्व में एक टीम का गठन किया गया था। टीम ने घेराबंदी कर शिवानी कॉलोनी स्थित कोडीन सिरप के कथित गोदाम पर छापेमारी की। इस दौरान भारी मात्रा में नशीली दवा बरामद की गई।

अधिकारियों के अनुसार, इससे पहले भी इसी इलाके में छापेमारी के दौरान बड़ी मात्रा में कोडीन सिरप और नशीले इंजेक्शन बरामद किए जा चुके हैं। लगातार कार्रवाई के बावजूद नशीले पदार्थों के कारोबार से जुड़े लोगों पर पूरी तरह अंकुश नहीं लग पा रहा है।

स्थानीय स्तर पर यह भी आरोप लगाए जा रहे हैं कि शराब और अन्य नशीले पदार्थों की बिक्री कई इलाकों में चोरी-छिपे जारी है। कोडीन सिरप और नशीले इंजेक्शन का इस्तेमाल करने वाले युवा भी कई स्थानों पर दिखाई देते हैं। ऐसे में नशीले पदार्थों के अवैध कारोबार को लेकर प्रशासन के सामने बड़ी चुनौती बनी हुई है।

लगातार हो रही बरामदगी से यह सवाल भी उठ रहा है कि आखिर नशीले पदार्थों की आपूर्ति करने वाले नेटवर्क के पीछे कौन लोग हैं और कौन युवाओं को नशे की गिरफ्त में धकेल रहा है। स्थानीय लोगों का कहना है कि ऐसे मामलों में सिर्फ छोटे स्तर के आरोपियों पर कार्रवाई के बजाय नशे के पूरे नेटवर्क और इसके पीछे सक्रिय माफिया पर सख्त कार्रवाई की आवश्यकता है।



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
